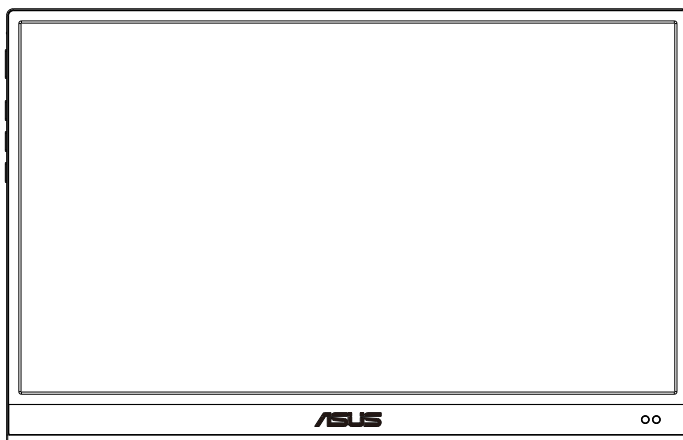

Care & cleaning

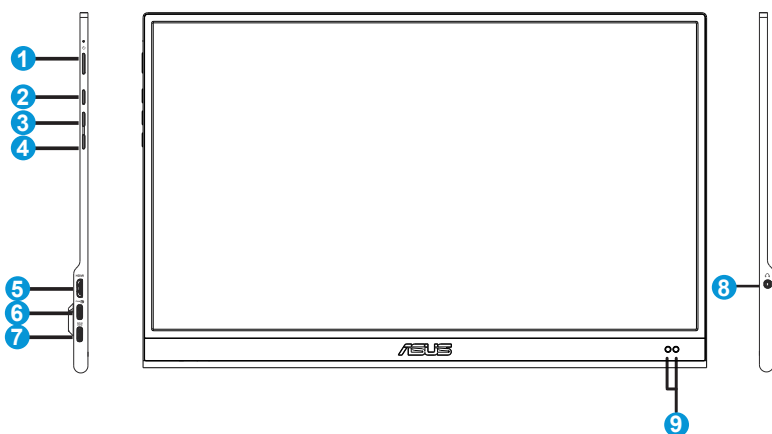

1.3 Monitor introduction

1.3.1 Front view



1. Power button/Power LED

- Press this button to turn the monitor on/off.
- The color definition of the power indicator is as the below table.

Status	Description
Blue	ON
Amber	Standby mode
Dark	OFF

2. Menu button

- Press this button to enter the OSD menu.

3. Close Button

- Exit the OSD menu.

4. Signal Button & Shortcut Button

- Default setting for this button is “Signal”, it can be used to switch input source.
- “Signal” can be replaced with other frequent used function, go to “Shortcut” and select your favorite function.
- Key Lock shortcut key. Press and hold it for 5 seconds to enable/disable Keys Lock.

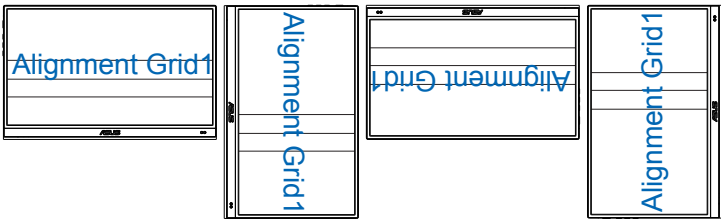
5. Mini HDMI port
6. USB Type-C port(^{30W})
 - Support DP alt mode, Used to connect to a valid source such as Notebook/PC/Mobile phone; signal input supports maximum to resolution 1920 x 1080 @60Hz
 - Up to PD10W power requires connection to a ASUS PD 30W adapter firstly
7. USB Type-C port()
 - DC IN to adapter, up to 20V@1.5A 30W power supply by inbox PD adapter
8. Earphone
9. Proximity sensor

1.3.2 QuickFit Function

The QuickFit function contains two patterns: (1) Grid (2) Photo size.

1. Grid pattern: Facilitates designers and users to organize content and layout on one page and achieve a consistent look and feel.

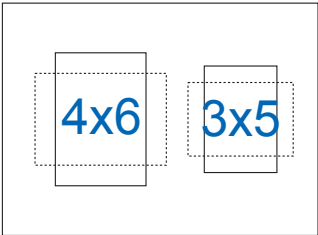
Alignment grid 1 will be rotated automatically if auto rotation is enabled.



- Auto rotation function is only working under Windows OS by installing DisplayWidget software.

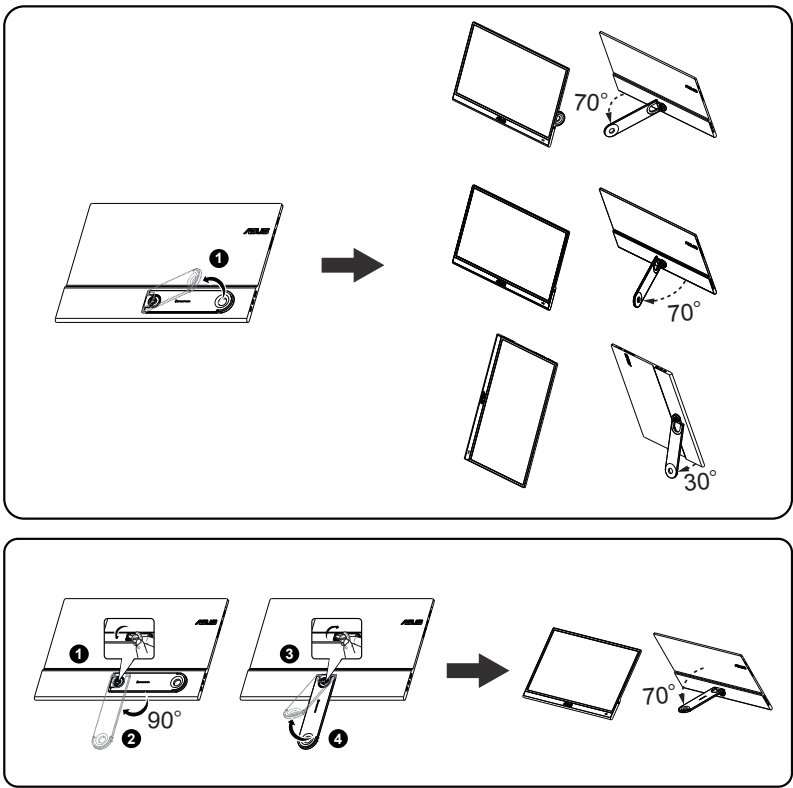


2. Photo size: Provides photographers and other users to accurately view and edit their photos in real size on the screen.



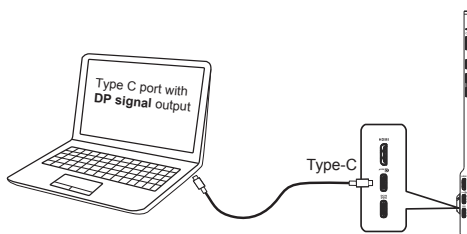

- USB monitor is working by acquiring power from PC/NB when monitor adapter is not plugged in. If USB monitor detects low power output from PC/NB, the “brightness” of monitor will be fixed at “up to 50 or 80 depends on how much of input power detected”, this behavior can avoid monitor from turning off instantly due to lack of power. For higher brightness, please plug in the monitor adapter, the system will enable brightness adjustment to maximum value again.

2.3 Announcements

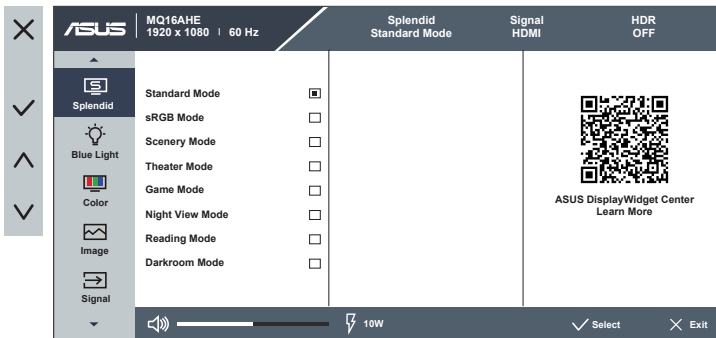
As this product and attached smart cover includes magnet in the structure, there could be potential risk to cause the damage of computer hard disc and objects that are sensitive to magnet.

3.1 OSD (On-Screen Display) menu

3.1.1 How to reconfigure

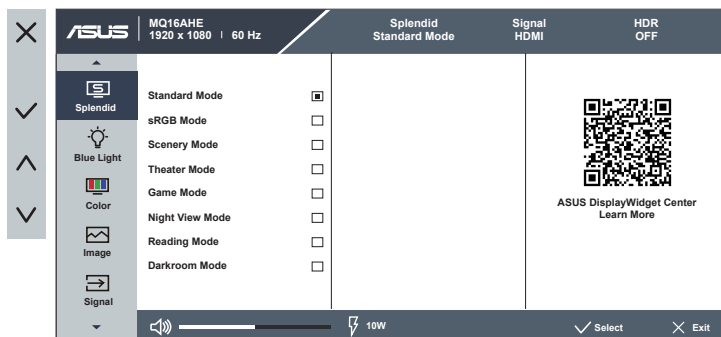


1. Press the MENU button to activate the OSD menu.
2. Press the $\wedge$ / $\vee$ button to toggle between options in the Menu. As you move from one icon to another, the option name is highlighted.
3. To select the highlighted item on the menu press the $\checkmark$ button.
4. Press the $\wedge$ / $\vee$ button to select the desired parameter.
5. Press the $\checkmark$ button to enter the slide bar and then use the $\wedge$ / $\vee$ button, according to the indicators on the menu, to make your changes.
6. Select the $\times$ to return to previous menu or $\checkmark$ to accept and return to previous menu.

3.1.2 OSD Function Introduction

1. Splendid

This function contains eight sub-functions that you can select for your preference.



- **Standard Mode:** This is the best choice for document editing with SPLENDID™ Video Intelligence Technology.
- **sRGB Mode:** This is the best choice for viewing photos and graphics from PCs.
- **Scenery Mode:** This is the best choice for scenery photo displaying with SPLENDID™ Video Intelligence Technology.
- **Theater Mode:** This is the best choice for movie watching with SPLENDID™ Video Intelligence Technology.
- **Game Mode:** This is the best choice for game playing with SPLENDID™ Video Intelligence Technology.
- **Night View Mode:** This is the best choice for playing dark-scene game or watching dark-scene movie with SPLENDID™ Video Intelligence Technology.
- **Reading Mode :** This is the best choice for book reading.
- **Darkroom Mode :** This is the best choice for a weak ambient light environment.



- In the Standard Mode, the Saturation, Sharpness, are not user-configurable.
- In the sRGB, the Saturation, Color Temp., Sharpness, Contrast functions are not user-configurable.
- In the Reading Mode, the Saturation, contrast, and Color Temp functions are not user-configurable.

2. Blue Light

Adjust the energy level of Blue Light emitted from OLED backlight.



- **Blue Light:** In this function, you can adjust the Blue Light from Min to max. Min: no changes; Max: The higher the level, the less Blue Light is scattered. When Blue Light is activated, the default settings of Standard Mode will be automatically imported. Besides maximum level, the brightness is user-configurable. Maximum is the optimized setting. It is compliance with TUV low Blue Light certification*. The brightness function is not user configurable.



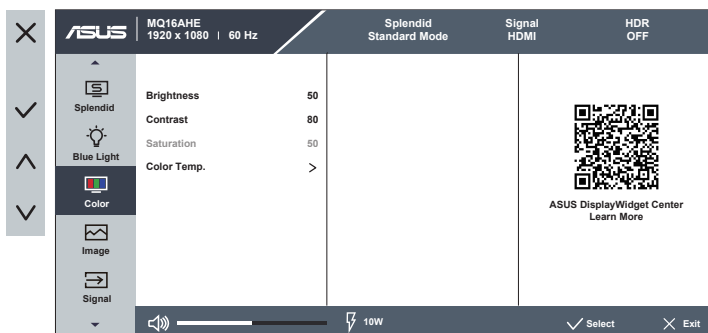

Please refer to the following to alleviate eye strains:

- Users should take some time away from the display if working for long hours. It is advised to take short breaks (at least 5 mins) after around 1 hour of continuous working at the computer. Taking short and frequent breaks is more effective than a single longer break.
 - To minimize eye strain and dryness in your eyes, users should rest the eye periodically by focusing on objects that are far away.
 - Eye exercises can help to reduce eye strain. Repeat these exercises often. If eye strain continues please consult a physician. Eye exercises: (1) Repeating look up and down (2) Slowly roll your eyes (3) Move your eyes diagonal.
 - High energy Blue Light may lead to eye strain and AMD (Age-Related Macular Degeneration). Blue Light to reduce 70% (max.) harmful Blue Light to avoiding CVS (Computer Vision Syndrome).

3. Color

Select the image color you like from this function.



- **Brightness:** The adjusting range is from 0 to 100. When HDR is enabled, the brightness cannot be adjusted.
- **Contrast:** The adjusting range is from 0 to 100.
- **Saturation:** The adjusting range is from 0 to 100.
- **Color Temp.:** Contains three preset color modes (**Cool**, **Normal**, **Warm**) and **User Mode**.



- When monitor is connected to input device by Type C port, and monitor detects power from input device is too low, the brightness will be fixed at up to 50 or 80 depends on how much of power received by monitor. As soon as the adapter is plugged in, the brightness can be adjusted to maximum value again.
- In the User Mode, colors of R (Red), G (Green), and B (Blue) are user-configurable; the adjusting range is from 0 ~ 100.

4. Image

You can adjust the image Sharpness, Aspect Control, VividPixel, and HDR from this main function.



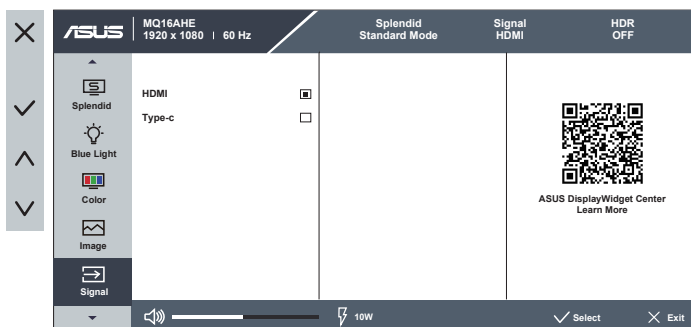
- **Sharpness:** Adjusts the picture sharpness. The adjusting range is from 0 to 100.
- **Aspect Control:** Adjusts the aspect ratio to “Full”, “Equivalent”.
- **VividPixel:** ASUS Exclusive Technology that brings lifelike visuals for crystal-clear and detail-oriented enjoyment. The adjusting range is from 0 to 100.
- **HDR:** High Dynamic Range. Contains two HDR modes, Cinema HDR and Gaming HDR, this item is open to choose when HDR is enabled.



- When displaying HDR content, image is optimized by HDR standard, the following function(s) are thus not available: Splendid, Blue Light, Color.

5. Signal

Select the input source from **HDMI, Type-C**, input signal.



6. Settings

Adjusts the system configuration.



- **OLED Setup:** Special setup according to OLED characteristics. Screen protection can be activated here, you might see the pixel shifting in using but this behavior does not influence usage and image clarity. This mechanism is designed to protect OLED from burn in issue, we suggest you always turn it on.
- **Volume:** Adjusts the output volume level.
- **GamePlus:** The GamePlus Function provides a toolkit and creates a better gaming environment for users when playing different types of games. Particularly, Crosshair function is specially designed for new gamers or beginners interested in First Person Shooter (FPS) games.
To active GamePlus:
 - Select **ON** to enter the GamePlus main menu.
 - Press **^ / v** button to select between Crosshair, Timer and Display Alignment function.

- Press ✓ to confirm the function you choose. Select ✕ to go off, and exit.



- **QuickFit:** See page 1-4 for details.
- **Power Saving:** Adjusts the “Normal Level “and” Deep Level” for the Power Saving function.
- **OSD Setup:** Adjusts the **OSD Timeout**, **DDC/CI**, and **Transparency** of the OSD screen.
- **Language:** Select OSD language. The selections are: **English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Dutch, Russian, Poland, Czech, Croatia, Hungary, Romania, Portugal, Turkey, Simplified Chinese, Traditional Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Persian, Thai, Indonesian, Ukrainian, Vietnamese.**
- **Key Lock:** Disable all key functions. Pressing the ∨ button for more than five seconds to disable key lock function.
- **Information:** Displays the monitor information.
- **Power Indicator:** Turn the power LED indicator on/off.

- **Proximity Sensor:** Embedded proximity sensor prompts the monitor to switch power saving mode when it detects the user is away for above a minute and resumes normal operation when user comes back. The function is optimized when the distance between user and the monitor is within 50cm. And please avoid any obstacle in front of the proximity sensor on the front bezel.
Note: the sensitivity of sensor might be influenced by the ambient light, color of users' clothing and monitor use angle.
- **Power Key Lock:** To disable / enable power key.
- **All Reset:** Selects "Yes" to revert all settings to the factory default mode.

7. MyFavorite

You can adjust Shortcut and Customized Setting from this main function.



- **Shortcut** : User can select from “Blue Light” “Splendid”, “Brightness”, “Contrast”, “Signal”, “Energy Saving” and set as shortcut key. The default setting is Signal.
- **Customized Setting** : You can do your setting according to your favorite.

3.3 Troubleshooting (FAQ)

Problem	Possible Solution
Power LED is not ON	• Press the  button to check if the monitor is in the ON mode. • Check if the USB Type-C cable is properly connected to the monitor and the computer.
The power LED lights amber and there is no screen image	• Check if the monitor and the computer are in the ON mode. • Make sure the USB Type-C cable is properly connected between the Portable USB Monitor and the computer. • Inspect the signal cable and make sure none of the pins are bent. • Connect the computer with another available monitor to check if the computer is properly working.
Screen image is too light or dark	• Adjust the Brightness settings via the button.
Screen image bounces or a wave pattern is present in the image	• Make sure the USB Type-C cable is properly connected between the Portable USB Monitor and the computer. • Move electrical devices that may cause electrical interference.
Screen image has color defects (white does not look white)	• Inspect the USB Type-C cable and make sure that none of the pins are bent.
HDR content is not played properly	• Make sure the input source supports HDR playback (with proper system settings and latest software). • Make sure the content is HDR encoded.

*1: White color background will consume higher power, so it's better to use white color background to test the power limit from source USB Type-C device.

*2: If MQ16AHE does not re-start when adjusting to value 100, that means source USB Type-C device has sufficient power supply.
