We therefore, recommend you to remove your camera while carrying the tripod.

Setting up

♠ Caution



To prevent accidental falls or tripod tipping over, making sure all levers, knobs and handles on the tripod are securely tightened.


And all of the three legs are opened all the way.

Attaching the camera to the quick release shoe



SPRINT MINI II BHAC

Remove the quick release shoe to loosen the shoe lock knob until the quick release shoe can be removed from the platform.



Screw the camera mounting screw on the tripod attachment screw of your camera and fix firmly.




Fix the shoe lock knob firmly after inserting the quick release shoe to the platform.


Please make sure the equipment is securely fixed to the ball head, before you use the ball head.

Using the ball head


Extending the tripod legs

Operating the center column






A camera can be moved freely while the ball lock lever is loosened. Tighten the ball lock lever when a camera angle is determined. Make sure to hold your camera while operating the ball lock lever.



Flip the leg lock lever up to extend or shorten the section to the desired length.

Press the leg lock lever(s) flush against the leg to lock.




Hold the camera with one hand. Loosen the center column lock. Raise or lower the camera to desired height.


While maintaining a hold, set the desired height of the camera, tighten the center column lock.



For best results and to avoid unnecessary camera vibrations, try to keep the center column height to a minimum if possible. Also use the larger legs first when extending the legs.


R.F.M Three position adjustable legs





Move the leg up slowly, it will make a ratchet noise at a certain point.


Move the leg up until stop, this position is the low position.




Close the leg further, a middle position or regular leg position can be chosen.

Close the leg slightly and slide the R.F.M lock lever down.

Low position




Remove the lower part of the center column when setting the legs in the lowerest position.




Turn the lower part of the center column in the direction of the arrow. (counter clockwise) Attach the center column stopper to the bottom of the upper center column to prevent the center column from falling out of the body.

Inverting the center column

⚠ Caution




- 1) Always remove the ball head first before replacing the center column.
- 2 Loosen the center column lock.



- 3 Remove the center column stopper.
- 4 Then loosen the center column stopper and pull out the center column.

♠ Caution



Insert the center column from the lower side of main body, and tighten the center column lock.

Make sure to re-attach the center column stopper in order to prevent the center column from falling out accidentally.

Care of the product

- DO NOT apply any grease or oil to this product.
- · Clean with a mild detergent and a soft cloth only.
- DO NOT use close to flame. Avoid extreme heat.
