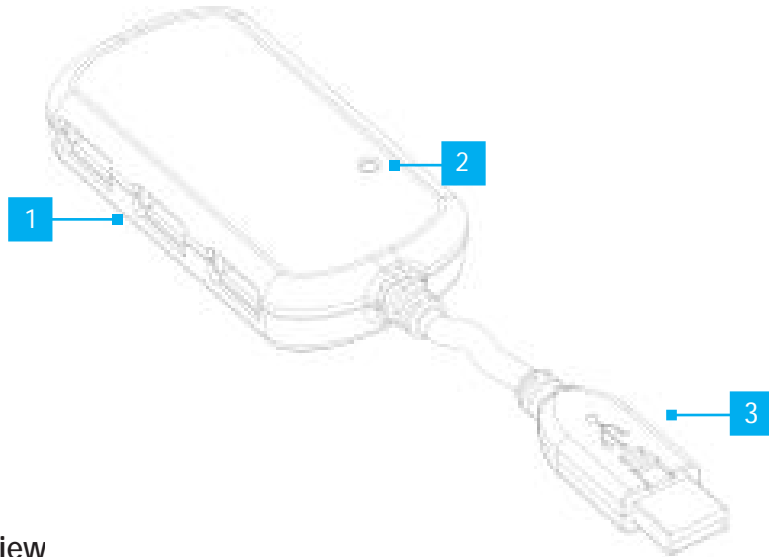


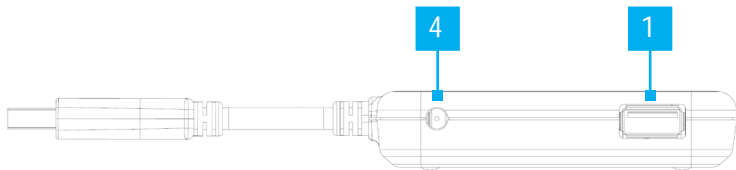

*No drivers are needed for the USB active cable with USB hub.*

2. Connect the **Power Adapter** to a **Power Outlet** and into the **DC Power Port** of the **USB Active cable with USB Hub**.

3. Connect a **USB Peripheral Device** to any of the four **USB-A Peripheral Ports**.

*Some USB peripheral devices may need drivers to finish their installation.*
