Clearing a paper jam

IMPORTANT: Be sure the output tray is lowered before opening the cover. Do not pull the jammed document out of the Scan Station; open the Scan Station cover first.

1. Open the Scan Station cover.



2. Remove any jammed document(s), close the Scan Station cover and resume scanning.

Multifeeds

If the Scan Station is configured to **Stop Scanning** when a multifeed occurs:

The Scan Station will beep and stop feeding documents. The multifeed document
will exit the Scan Station. A message will be displayed to Scan or Cancel. The
multifeed document will not generate an image. If you want to rescan the document,
put the document back in the input tray and touch Scan.

If the Scan Station is configured to **Continue Scanning** when a multifeed occurs:

• The Scan Station will beep and continue scanning. The multifeed document will be imaged.



Be sure output tray panel is down.


Adjust input and output tray extenders.


Getting your documents ready to scan
