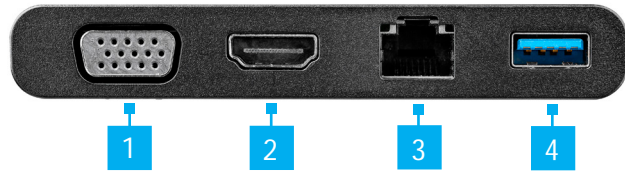


USB-C Multiport Adapter with HDMI | VGA

1	VGA Port	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connect a VGA Video Display Device to the Host Computer. Max resolution 1920x1200@60Hz.
2	HDMI Port	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connect an HDMI Video Display Device to the Host Computer. Max resolution 4096 x 2160p @ 24Hz or 3860 x 2160p @ 30Hz. <p><i>Note: The Multiport Adapter is a single video display adapter. You can connect either an HDMI Display or a VGA Display.</i></p>
3	RJ45 Port	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connect a Network Device to the Host Computer.
4	USB-A Port	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connect a USB Device to the Multiport Adapter (Flash Drive, Mouse, etc.).

Connecting the Multiport Adapter

Note: *The Multiport Adapter is a single video display adapter. You can connect either an HDMI Display or a VGA Display. If you connect a Display to both the HDMI Port and VGA Port only the Display connected to the HDMI Port will function correctly.*

VGA Port

The **VGA Port** is used to connect the **Multiport Adapter** to a **VGA Device**.

1. Connect a **VGA Cable** to the **VGA Port** on the **Multiport Adapter**.
2. Connect the other end of the **VGA Cable** to the **VGA Port** on a **Video Display Device** and (if applicable) tighten the two screws on either side on the **VGA Connector**.

HDMI Port

The **HDMI Port** is used to connect the **Multiport Adapter** to an **HDMI Device**.

1. Connect an **HDMI Cable** to the **HDMI Port** on the **Multiport Adapter**.
2. Connect the other end of the **HDMI Cable** to an **HDMI In Port** on a **Video Display Device**.

RJ45 Port

The **RJ45 Port** is used to connect a **Network Device** to the **Multiport Adapter**.

1. Connect a **CAT5e/CAT6 Cable** to the **RJ45 Port** on the **Multiport Adapter**.
2. Connect the other end of the **CAT5e/CAT6 cable** to an **RJ45 Port** on a compatible **Network Device**.

USB-A Port

The **USB-A Port** can be used to connect a USB storage device (e.g. Flash Drive) or other USB peripheral device (e.g. Keyboard, Mouse, etc.).

- Connect a **USB-A Connector/Device** to the **USB-A Port** on the **Multiport Adapter**.

Powering the Multiport Adapter

The **Multiport Adapter** is powered by the host laptop's **USB-C Port** and does not require a separate power adapter.

1. Connect the **USB-C Connector** on the **Multiport Adapter's** attached **Hideaway Cable (rear)** to a **USB-C Port** on the **Host Computer**.
