



Getting started




First, connect the desk phone and PC cables to the base. For information on your specific phone, refer to http://www.jabra.com/compatibilityguide

Connect to power




Stereo and Mono




Then plug the base into a power supply. Press Vol + and Vol - simultaneously to enter the setup menu to help you connect to your computer or desk phone.
